If you get the Academy Prayer Calendar each month, you know a little about the activities we have with our students, especially prisoners. If you do not receive the prayer calendar, we will happily send it to you each month if you let us know. Here are a few excerpts from recent correspondence:

Robel was released from a prison in California last month and here is part of what he wrote while waiting to leave:

"I turned my life over to Christ in 2017. I loved the Lord, but I was tied to drugs, pornography, and other sins. In 2019 I turned myself in to the authorities of the USA to pay my debt and to start to live free in Christ."

Pray for him that he will continue with the Lord.

Kelly, from a prison close to us says,

"Thank you all for your thoughtfulness and kindness. Your consideration, time, and service you give to us is truly appreciated. You give us hope and inspire us beyond words can express."

From a Washington state penitentiary, José wrote,

"I have little time reading the Bible and I think I am having a spiritual awakening. Can you help me with Bible studies to prepare me to have a better understanding about the Word of God?"

Alvaro is in prison in California and said in a recent letter,

"I lived many years far away from my Savior, but thanks to His grace and mercy, in 2015 I surrendered my life and will to my Savior. Another religious group gave me your address. None of you know me but you are helping me with my rehabilitation and spiritual growth. Thank you very much."

As a reminder, the Christian Academy of the Air is a Spanish Bible correspondence and online school, 22 studies (20 are books 150-225 pages each) on a Bible school/seminary level. We also now have the first two studies in English. We charge nothing for prisoners to study.

One ongoing concern for us in the Academy is the diminished amount of communication we have with prisoners. For example, with inmates in Texas we have to send everything to a Dallas address and pray they will forward the courses to our students. Thanks for joining us in prayer regarding this problem.

On the bright side we have a former prisoner, now a chaplain, who is starting to distribute our Academy information to six prisons here in Texas. We are anxiously waiting to receive correspondence from hundreds of new students!

If you are a pray-er, remember the Academy director, Josefina Ríos, who has a heavy load, especially because we still do not have any employees, only



volunteers and another "elderly" missionary besides me helping. This is because we do not have enough incoming money yet to hire somebody. You may recall that the Academy sponsors a Mothers' Day luncheon every year. Last year we had over 500 so you can understand what a huge opportunity it is for us to present the Gospel and to enroll new students. The local police department is a co-sponsor, and many businesses contribute to the expenses of this large event. Thanks for your prayers.
